
Community Outreach Ministry sponsored by Prince of Faith

LAY ACADEMY SESSIONS: Jan. 21, Jan. 28, Feb. 4, Feb. 11

If you're interested in growing your faith, learning more about the Bible, and expanding your knowledge in leadership and service, consider participating in a *Lay Academy* session. We're inviting some of the most talented, engaging speakers and teachers to provide education and training to you in a way never experienced within the church tradition.

The *Lay Academy* is a new program of the *Lutheran* Theological Seminary and four Western Synods of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC), that seeks to provide continuing education opportunities for lay people in the church and for those being prepared for the ELCIC's National Authorized Lay Ministry program. The establishment of the *Lay Academy* is in response to the leadership needs of congregations and the interest expressed by lay people for a comprehensive program of study.

The 'LA' sessions are provided through a unique online format that allows multiple sites from across the four Western provinces and Territories to listen and interact with the presenter at the same time, while also enjoying discussion led by a facilitator within a local church setting. It makes for a collaborative teaching and learning experience.

From January 21 through to February 11, 2017 there will be 4 consecutive Saturday sessions in which you can partake in a series teaching on *Galatians: What is the Good News that Sets Us Free*?

The sessions are slated to run from 10:30 am to 12 pm AB/NWT Time. Registration fees are \$15 per session or \$50 for the series of 4. Registration to open online January 9th.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY 2017:

Reconciliation – **The Love of Christ Compels Us** (cf. 2 Corinthians 5:14-20)

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an annual ecumenical celebration traditionally held from January 18 to 25. By coming together during this week, we join with the people around the world to pray for Christian unity – in worship, reflection, study, and fellowship.



This year, we have the opportunity to pray with the Christians of Germany. They have chosen as their theme "Reconciliation – The Love of Christ Compels Us," inspired by 2 Corinthians 5:14-20. They invite Christians around the world to celebrate God's reconciling grace, call us to recognize the pain of the deep divisions which afflict the Church, and urge us to become ambassadors of Christ's message of reconciliation.

You can use the resources on the Canadian Council of Churches website not only during the Week of Prayer itself, but throughout the year. Let them help you express the degree of communion already given to the churches, and to pray together that we may be more fully united in the one Christ.


